OISSE Co-Director Presents in Haiti

Omaha, Nebraska (May, 4, 2006) --- Member of a team of six healthcare professionals, Caroline Goulet, PT, PhD, recently participated in the International Child Care Grace Children's Hospital Second Annual Scientific Day, a pediatric continuing education course for health care professionals and students in Port-au-Prince, Haiti. International Child Care (ICC) is an international non-profit organization with a vision of "health and wholeness for children and families in empowered communities" involved in Haiti since 1967 and in the Dominican Republic since 1988. Grace Children's Hospital specializes in the treatment of children with tuberculosis and HIV/AIDS. As rehabilitation is not currently a priority for Haiti's basic needs, Dr. Goulet presented on basic techniques to optimize pulmonary functions in patients that are bedridden.

After leading the Creighton physical therapy student transcultural clinical experience in the Dominican Republic for four years, and as co-director of the School of Pharmacy and Health Professions' Office of Interprofessional Scholarship, Service and Education (OISSE), Dr. Goulet is currently coordinating interprofessional efforts to explore international outreach opportunities for students and faculty. She also serves as Vice President on the Board of International Child Care-USA.
