EDUCATING FOR MORAL ACTION BOOK RECEIVES JESUIT BOOK AWARD

Omaha, Nebraska (October 4, 2006) --- *Educating for Moral Action: A Sourcebook for Health and Rehabilitation Ethics* published by F.A. Davis was selected for the 2006 Alpha Sigma Nu Jesuit Book Award in the category of the sciences. The book is a publication of the proceedings from the 2003 Leadership in Ethics Education Conference held at Creighton University. This Conference was co-sponsored by the Center for Health Policy and Ethics (CHPE) and the Office of Interprofessional Scholarship, Service and Education (OISSE) with funding from Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA) grant # 1 D37 HP 00824-01 *Dreamcatchers and the Common Good: Allied Health Leadership in Generational Health and Ethics*.

The Leadership in Ethics Education Conference gathered leaders from across physical and occupational therapy to discuss ethics education in both fields. The text focuses on pedagogical strategies that will ultimately change the face of how educators think and, consequently, how they teach ethics to the next generation of health professionals.

Dr. Ruth Purtilo, of the Massachusetts General Hospital Institute of Health Professions; Dr. Gail Jensen, Dean of the Graduate School and Associate Vice President for Faculty Development at Creighton University; and Dr. Charlotte Royeen, Dean of the Doisy College of Health Sciences at Saint Louis University acted as editors for the book.
